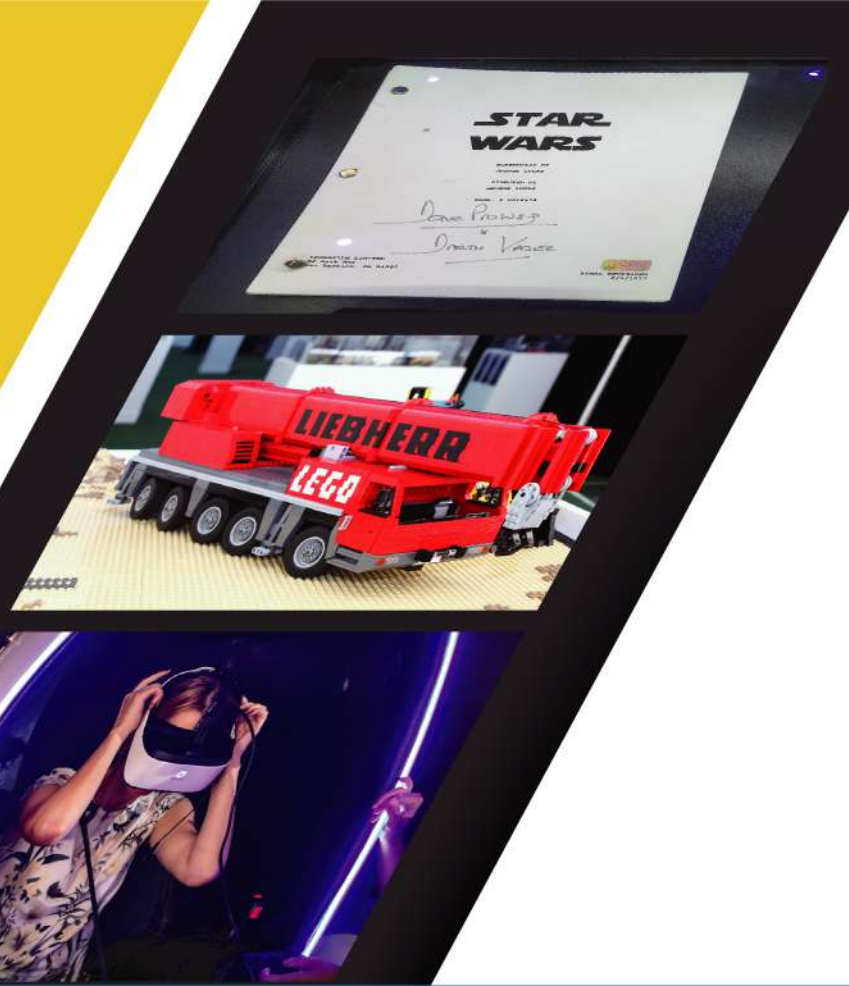

One of the Largest Private Star Wars Collections on Earth

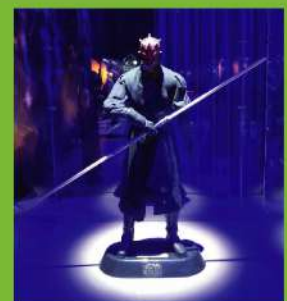

Unofficial Galaxies is one of the world's largest private collections of Star Wars memorabilia, but it is more than a showcase of movie props: it's a tribute to the power of imagination and the artistry that connects us across time, cultures, and generations. With 142 exhibits across 22 immersive scenes, the exhibition transforms iconic Star Wars moments into a curated tapestry of art, design, and human connection. These are not just props and costumes, they are capturing the hopes, fears, and dreams of humanity through a futuristic lens. The battle between good and evil.

Highlights Include:

- A life-size Landspeeder, originally housed at London's legendary Elstree Studios—where the saga began.
- The desk and chair of young Anakin Skywalker, original from The Phantom Menace.
- Legendary figures like Yoda, Han Solo in Carbonite, and Darth Maul, captured as sculptural icons of storytelling and design.
- Costume ensembles of iconic characters such as Princess Leia, Luke Skywalker, Darth Vader, Jango Fett, and The Emperor—each a tribute to character design as wearable art.
- A curated display of dozens of rare Star Wars toys from 1977 to 1999, offering a nostalgic window into the childhoods and dreams of millions.

As you walk through, you are not just seeing objects—you are stepping into the visual poetry of a modern myth. From hand-crafted armours to production artefacts, every piece reflects our timeless drive to explore, believe, and connect.

Where Bricks Tell the Story of Human Innovation

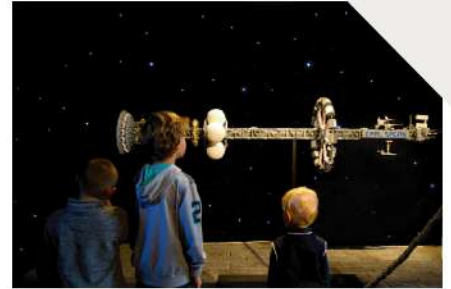

Mission To The Moon – Relive History

(180sqmt / 1,800sqft, 12-14 minutes experience)

Feel the thrill of the first Moon landing! Mission To The Moon takes you back to one of the most historic moments of the 20th century. Using cutting-edge VR, vibrating platforms, and immersive 4D seats, you will: step into the shoes of an astronaut, feel the rumble of a rocket launch, experience the first human steps on the Moon.

This adrenaline-pumping VR adventure will make you feel what the pioneers of space exploration felt: an unmissable journey into history!

Illusions – Enter the World of Escher

(121sqmt / 1,210sqft, 8-10 minutes experience)

Step into the mind-bending universe of Maurits Cornelis Escher, the legendary master of visual paradoxes! This surreal VR experience goes beyond just looking at his artwork: you'll live it! Walk through impossible staircases that loop endlessly, labyrinths that defy logic, geometries that bend reality.

Dinosaur Invasion

Dinosaur Invasion is among the most fascinating, immersive and attractive experience of recent years.

This exhibition with a made in Italy touch features over 40 life-size dinosaurs, each of them housed in its own natural habitat recreated according to specific geological eras, within a large Jurassic park.

The itinerary consists of a sequence of islands reproducing the vegetation and habitat of the several species, and permits the visitor to follow dinosaurs evolution from the late Triassic when the first specimens appeared, passing through the Jurassic era, until their extinction which occurred at the end of the Cretaceous about 65 million years ago.

The structure can be fully customised using different numbers of dinosaurs and scenes, for exhibition areas from 200 up to 5000 square meters. Scenes are top-class, including a volcano and a waterfall.

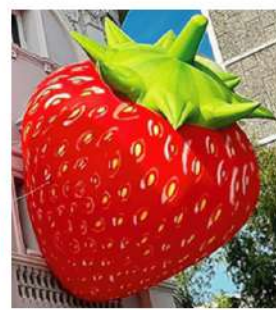

Sharks



Sharks, perfect predators that have inhabited the seas for 400 million years, well before the appearance of vertebrates, and have remained almost unchanged over time. The exhibition will lead to the discovery of more than 30 specimens from the 6m great white shark to the tiger shark, the hammerhead, the fox, the leucas, up to the smallest existing, the pygmy shark.

You will discover why, despite the few cases of deaths, sharks have the reputation of eating men. Models of human limbs with shark bite wounds will be visible to observe their characteristics.

It will be possible to enter and photograph yourself in the shark cage. Get a close-up look at the giant white shark, its jaws and mouth closing on its prey.

Among the most spectacular adaptations stands out the cookie cutter shark, capable of detaching biscuit-shaped pieces of meat in cetaceans and even in humans.

You will be able to observe the internal anatomy, discover how a shark is born, touch the skin, feel the scales.

At the end of the visit, you will understand how sharks turned from a great predator to a prey; and how many species are on the verge of extinction.

Inferno

The poet, writer and politician Dante Alighieri is considered the father of the Italian language. Nicknamed "sommo poeta" ("supreme poet"), he was the first man of letters to use the vernacular in Italian literature. His main work, the Divine Comedy, is considered one of the masterpieces of world literature.

Inspired by the scenes represented in the 19th Century French artist Gustave Doré's engravings, Inferno (hell) recreates exceptionally realistic scenes offering a three-dimensional shape to Dante's visions of hell.

Charon, ferryman of souls in Hades, the Furies and the Harpies, many mythological creatures and animals belonging to medieval bestiaries, together with historical characters - met by Dante during his imaginary journey - who remind us of the historical events of the time.

A scary, beautiful, educational and entertaining exhibition.

Pandemics

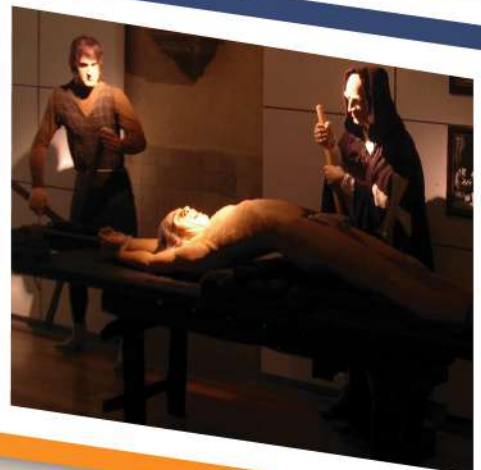
humans dark side

The history of the human race has been characterised by dozens of epidemics and pandemics caused by unknown viruses that we have come to know very well in recent times. These events have transformed the societies in which they have appeared and, quite possibly, decisively changed or influenced the course of history and human affairs.

Often in past eras, when medicine was unable to give answers and explanations to phenomena of great effect such as the plague, theories and treatments were born result of superstitions such as the devil, witchcraft, vampires... The old story of scapegoats born of ignorance...

Over 50 exhibits will show the history of epidemics as well as the sad dark side humans showed when facing such calamities - a dark side which brought racism, prejudice and iniquities towards free thinkers and minorities.

A powerful, educational, impressive exhibition with a highly educational value.

Mythos

mythological creatures

The myth arises from the need to explain reality, to overcome and resolve nature's contradictions; it is the imaginative way of explaining the origin of things. Myths are much more than a series of stories handed down by ancient people: they represent a fundamental part of every culture, they are the colour of history.

In the myth, a cosmogony of divinities made of real and fantasy animals (huge snakes, lions, monstrous dogs, goats, horses, bulls, eagles) and human parts live and transform themselves, so as to compose creatures often representing mankind's negative characteristics. These divinities are not only charged with magic and power, but also suffer and amplify the evils that afflict mankind: anger, misfortune, infidelity, unhappiness.

Mythos - Mythological Creatures consists of 32 life-size models of mythological creatures created by taxidermy and sculptural techniques. The dimensions of the specimens range from a 13-metres dragon to a 6-metres Pegasus among others. Each creature lives in its own world created with the best landscaping techniques and new technologies such as: AR, NFC integration, QR code explanation panels, immersive room experience, high quality projectors.

Felines

Objects of veneration in ancient times, felines represent a powerful mix of strength and elegance, but now also of extreme fragility: in the last 20 years their numbers have decreased considerably, so much so that 13% of wild cats are classified as endangered species with a much declining populations, and 34% are considered vulnerable. This exhibition aims to spread the knowledge about these beautiful creatures and the danger they are facing.

The specimens in the exhibition come from zoological gardens, natural parks, recovery centres where they died of natural causes, and later donated for exhibition purposes. They have all been prepared with a highly skilled taxidermy technique.

All major felines are represented in the exhibition, which will allow to see up close and personal some of the most beautiful animals in our world.



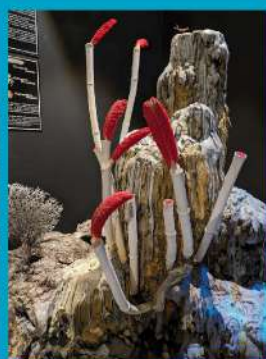

The marine ecosystem is the widest environment on earth. Sunlight only penetrates oceans up to 200 meters, and here is concentrated the majority of marine organisms we know. Proceeding downwards, the water temperature tends to decrease: at 2000 metres the temperature is 3°C and at 3000 metres only 2°C; on the seabed it can touch 0°C. The pressure increases by 1atm every ten meters. The deep sea is therefore an extreme environment, inhabited by few organisms for the most part still unknown.

With this exhibition we seek to raise awareness of the beauty and the incredible life forms found in the deepest abysses. These species are shaped by pressure, by absolute darkness and deep frost, have incredible shapes that seem to belong to an almost imaginary world. But the darkness is never absolute, and abyssal depths are lit intermittently by his inhabitants' chemical lights...

The exhibition takes place in semi-darkness. The protagonists include large specimens such as the 13-metres long giant squid, and the 4-metres long Bluntnose shark. In total more than 100 species are featured in the exhibition. 54 of these, some taxidermized and other in models, have bright colors and light up when illuminated by ultraviolet light.

Insects

One of the best ways to learn to respect life, is knowledge: all animals and plants have a biological role to play in our world.

Insects are everywhere: from the tropics to the poles, on land, in air and in water - in fact more than three quarters of the known species are insects. They have an important role to play in the ecosystem, hence the need to understand and recognise their role in the world.

What better way to do so than through a series of interactive activities promoting meaningful learning and knowledge for children, youths and adults?

The exhibition is a guided tour in a spectacular display, where one can experience dozens of insects of the most impressive and beautiful species in the world: from the beautiful giant tropical beetles of Asia and South America, to grasshoppers and water insects.

The exhibition also features 3D models of insects up to two metres tall. It explores topics such as reproduction, size, strength and aggression, mimicry, adaptation to life in water and interrelationships of these creatures with human life, whether good or bad.

Insects also shows display panels with palpable heads and legs of various insects that can be observed and manipulated to better understand them.
